Day-by-Day in Detail

<u>Wednesday, October 9th</u> - We will depart this morning and arrive in Wilkes-Barre, PA for a one-night stay at The Woodlands Resort. Meal & rest stops will be made en route.

<u>Thursday, October 10th</u> - Following breakfast, we will continue on to Newburgh, NY and begin our Hudson Valley adventure with a 2-hour narrated cruise through the majestic Hudson Highlands aboard the Pride of the Hudson. The captain will chronicle the sights along the way, including: Washington's HQ, Mount Beacon, Bannerman's Island, Breakneck Mountain, Cold Spring, Constitution Island, West Point and World's End (the deepest part of the Hudson River). A boxed lunch will be included to enjoy during the tour.

Later, we will continue on to our hotel and check-in for a 3-night stay. A group dinner will take place tonight at a local restaurant.

Friday, October 11th - After breakfast, head to West Point, NY, home of the United State Military Academy. Upon arrival at the Visitor's Center, a step-on guide will join us for a narrated 2-hour combined bus and walking tour which tells the story of West Point, its history & role in the Revolution, along with stories of graduates who helped shape our nation. The tour will bring the history of the Long Gray Line to the present as you learn of the cadet experience and West Point's continuing role in training the leaders of tomorrow. The tour will make numerous stops, including Cadet Chapel, The Plain (academic area), Trophy Point, West Point Cemetery and Old Cadet Chapel. Following the tour, ample free time will be provided to enjoy lunch on your own before returning to the hotel this afternoon. Later, enjoy a group dinner at a local restaurant.

Saturday. October 12th - This morning, visit the Franklin D Roosevelt National Historic Site. Home to the 32nd & longest-serving US President, FDR returned to Hyde Park often, drawing on this place to renew his spirit during times of personal and political crisis. Explore the Roosevelt legacy at the homes of Franklin & Eleanor Roosevelt, as well as the exhibits at the nation's first Presidential Library. We will also enjoy a guided tour of Springwood, FDR's boyhood home. Situated in a landscaped clearing on a bluff, overlooking the Hudson, it is the only place in the United States where a President was born, maintained a lifelong connection, and lies buried.

For lunch, continue to the lovely village of Rhinebeck for leisure time & dining on your own - Enjoy delicious american fare at Pete's Famous Restaurant or Foster's Coach House Tavern (operating since 1890), order a wood fired pizza at Pizzeria Posto, grab a quick sandwich or sub at Rhinebeck Bagels, and satisfy your sweet tooth with a stop at Samuel's Sweet Shop (Rhinebeck's Longest Running Coffee Bar & Sweet Shop). Later, watch an exciting air show at the Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome Museum. This non-profit focuses on the collecting, restoring and exhibiting of more than 60 aircraft of the Pioneer, WWI and Golden Ages of aviation.

For dinner tonight, we visit the Culinary Institute of America's flagship campus in Hyde Park, where you'll find yourself right in the heart of the Hudson Valley's thriving food community.

Sunday. October 13th - Following breakfast & hotel check-out, we will follow the River to the legendary town of Sleepy Hollow. En route, we will make a stop at Union Church of Pocantico Hills to view the marvelous stained glass windows of Henri Matisse & Marc Chagall. While in Sleepy Hollow, enjoy a 1-hr walking tour of the historic Sleepy Hollow Cemetery - Learn all about Washington Irving, his impact on American Literature and the enduring appeal of "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow", which recently celebrated its Bicentennial. Then, continue to Tarrytown NY for free time to shop & dine on your own before continuing to New York City.

We will arrive at our Times Square hotel later this afternoon and the remainder of the day & evening are at your leisure.

Please Note: If you are interested in seeing a Broadway show, tonight would be the night to do so, as most shows are "dark" on Mondays.

Monday, October 14th - Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore the Big Apple! A quintessential hub for all things culture, art, history, entertainment, and so much more, there is undoubtedly something for everyone. *Optional* For a little more guidance, purchase a ticket for a Hop-on/Hop-off Sightseeing Tour with Big Bus Tours. Your 1-day ticket includes: Uptown Loop (Stops: Times Square, Midtown East, MoMA, Central Park Zoo, Columbus Circle, Carnegie Hall), Downtown Loop (Stops: Times Square, Empire State Building/Koreatown, Flatiron District, SoHo, Chinatown/Little Italy, Brooklyn Bridge, Wall Street/Charging Bull, Battery Park, World Trade Center, Hudson Yards, Circle Line Pier), Audio Commentary (pre-recorded), unlimited Hop-on/Hop-off accessibility from 9a-5p (based on route schedules) \$80 per person

<u>Tuesday. October 15th</u> - Upon hotel check-out, we will travel home to Columbus, arriving this evening. Meal & rest stops will be made en route.
