Flights: Air from Columbus (CMH) to Portland (PDX) & returning from Spokane (GEG) is included.

Day-by-Day in Detail

<u>Thursday, September 19</u>th - Today, fly to Portland, OR. Upon arrival, our deluxe motor coach will transfer our group to a downtown hotel, where we will check-in for a 2-night stay. A delicious Welcome Dinner will take place at a local restaurant this evening.

Friday. September 20th - After breakfast, we will set out on a driving tour of Portland. Sights & stops may include: Portland Aerial Tram, South Waterfront, Riverplace, Powell's Books, Old Town & Chinatown. Following a stop for lunch on your own, we will continue to the International Rose Test Gardens at Washington Park for a guided tour. More than 10,000 individual rose bushes bloom in the International Rose Test Garden (IRTG) from late May through October, representing over 610 different rose varieties and the primary purpose of the Garden is to serve as a testing ground for new rose varieties. We will return to the hotel later this afternoon & the evening will be at your leisure.

Saturday. September 21st - This morning, following breakfast & hotel check-out, travel east into the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. Designated as such in the 1980's, you'd be hard-pressed to find vistas as stunning as these. At the western end of the Gorge, the view from Crown Point is a front-row seat to the mighty Columbia as it unfurls and cuts through the Cascade mountains. From there, dozens of awe-inspiring waterfalls spill from basalt cliffs, lining the Historic Columbia River Highway, like the famous Multnomah Falls. Arriving in Hood River, we board the scenic Mount Hood Railroad for a 2 ½ - 3 hour round trip tour, including a box lunch & stop at The Fruit Company. This evening, we will check into our accommodation in Kennewick, WA and dinner will be on your own.

<u>Sunday, September 22nd</u> - Start the day by exploring Fort Walla Walla. Located on the grounds of a 19th-century military fort, the Museum features a 17-building historic pioneer settlement, beautiful gardens, and five sprawling exhibit halls housing thousands of artifacts. Following ample free time and a stop for lunch, continue to Lewiston, ID and check-in to Hells Canyon Grand Hotel for a 2-night stay. Dinner tonight is included at the hotel.

Monday, September 23rd - Today, enjoy a day at leisure in Lewiston *or* join an *optional* half-day adventure on the Snake River. Travel through vast reaches of remote wilderness and whitewater rapids located along the borders of eastern Washington, western Idaho and eastern Oregon. Along the way, you will discover abundant wildlife, while hearing the history of Native Americans, steamships, missionaries, pioneers, miners, outlaws, mayhem and more along the way. Included is a freshly prepared deli-style packed lunch and beverages served picnic style under the fruit orchards of Cache Creek Ranch. We return to the hotel later this afternoon and the remaining day & evening will be at your leisure. *Hells Canyon Jet Boat Tour with Lunch \$175/person*

<u>Tuesday. September 24</u>th - Following breakfast & hotel check-out, we will travel north to Coeur d'Alene, ID. Arriving in town by noon, you will have plenty of time for lunch on your own, shopping, and exploring before our afternoon cruise around the lake. During the 90-minute narrated scenic cruise on Lake Coeur d'Alene, learn about the lake, watch wildlife, view secluded lake homes along the shore, and cruise alongside the world's only floating golf green. After, continue to Rider Ranch, a family-owned and operated working cattle & horse ranch. A horse-drawn wagon will take you for a 20-30 minute tour of the meadow, with possible viewing of cattle, horses, deer, elk or other wild animals. After the tour, return to their barn area to find steaks cooking on the grill & a full "cowboy" dinner of potatoes, baked beans, green salad, homemade bread and jams, finishing with dessert cooked in a Dutch oven & served with ice cream or make s'mores in the campfire. We will then check-in to our Coeur d'Alene hotel for a 2-night stay.

<u>Wednesday, September 25th</u> - After a leisurely morning, we will travel to Wallace, ID - Where history meets the Center of the Universe! An included tour of a Wallace Silver Mine will follow free time in town for lunch and to enjoy truly unique museums and historical sites that tell the stories of the railroaders, miners, working class heroes, and even "working girls" that carved this gem of a town from Idaho's beautiful Bitterroot Mountains. Fun Fact: Wallace is only 1 of 4 towns in the US whose entirety is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Tonight, we will end our amazing adventure with an authentic Native American Cultural Experience & Dinner.

<u>Thursday, September 26th</u> - This morning following breakfast & hotel check-out, we will transfer to Spokane WA for our return flights to Columbus and will arrive home this evening.

Deposit and Final Payment: A deposit of \$750 per person is due upon booking to secure your reservation. Final payment is due on or before June 21st, 2024.
