Day-by-Day in Detail

<u>Wednesday. April 2nd</u> - Today, we fly from Columbus to Honolulu. Upon arrival, be presented with a traditional lei greeting before continuing to our Waikiki hotel and check-in for our 7-night stay. Dinner tonight is on your own at the hotel or one of the many nearby restaurants.

<u>Thursday, April 3</u>rd - This morning, a special breakfast is included at Duke's Waikiki. A beachfront tiki restaurant, named in honor of Duke Kahanamoku, a local surfer who rode a monster wave over 1 mile at Waikiki Beach in 1929. Following breakfast, head to Pearl Harbor Visitor Center & National Memorial. Here you will have access to multiple museums, facilities, and a short film, exclusive to the memorial. *Please Note: Admission to the USS Arizona Memorial is subject to government admission restrictions.* We will then depart on a Honolulu City Tour with a local guide. During the tour, expected sights will be: The statue of King Kamehameha the Great, lolani Palace, Kawaiahao Church, Hawaiian Mission Houses Historic Site & Archives, Aloha Tower Marketplace, and Waikiki Beach. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Outside our hotel is the best in shopping, restaurants and the famous Waikiki Beach with wonderful views of Diamond Head.

<u>Friday, April 4th - A day of leisure awaits - Relax on the beach, shop, or explore the area & island.</u>

*Optional Day Tour - The Big Island of Hawai'i \$399/p: This morning, catch an early flight from Honolulu to Kona. This full day adventure of the Big Island begins in Kona & continues north on a scenic journey past historic Parker Ranch, which has operated as one of the largest ranches in America since 1847. As you pass through the ranching town of Waimea, watch as the landscape changes from pastures to green, tropical rainforest, as sweeping views of the Hamakua Coast start creeping into view. During a stop at Waipio Valley lookout, marvel at the way the vertical cliffs seem to explode from the green valley floor and hear the tales of how King Kamehameha was raised in this valley as a child. The adventure continues as you wind your way down the Hamakua Coast, past roadside towns with singsong names until you reach Akaka Falls and Rainbow Falls. Make your way back toward sea level at Punalu'u Beach, where you'll take a stroll on a black-sand beach and search for Hawaiian green sea turtles. Head next to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, before rounding the southern tip of the island, the southernmost point in America. Look out for Kealakekua Bay, the spot where Captain Cook was killed in a skirmish with Native Hawaiians. Stop at a Kona coffee farm to learn about the coffee growing process and walk through a lava tube. Your tour finishes back in Kona and you will fly back to Honolulu this evening.

<u>Saturday. April 5th</u> - Today, explore the island & surrounding area at your own pace. Tonight, rejoin the group for a delicious dinner at a local restaurant.

<u>Sunday. April 6</u>th - Today, embark on a full day Circle Island Tour of Oahu. Our early morning start will deliver us to Diamond Head Lookout to take in the sunrise. Next, pass by the Gold Coast in Kahala and Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve during the scenic drive to Eternity Beach and the Halona Blowhole, where we will stop for photo opportunities. Enjoy views of the Makapu'u coastline as you continue on to Byodo-In Temple, then some leisure time on Sandy Beach (known for its huge but dangerous waves). Later, continue the island drive with views of Mokoli'i Island, free time to explore the towns along Oahu's North Shore, and stops for snacks at Tropical Farms (The Macadamia Nut Farm Outlet) and Kahuku Farms. Your afternoon highlight is a tour of the historic Dole Plantation before returning to the hotel. This evening, we will enjoy a traditional Luau with dinner in Waikiki.

<u>Monday, April 7th - Another day of leisure rises with the tropical sun.</u>

*Optional Day Tour - The Garden Isle of Kauai \$399/p: This morning, catch an early flight from Honolulu to Lihue. Learn about the history of Kauai and the island's changing landscape as you make your way west. Pass through the historic town of Hanapepe, a popular stomping ground for soldiers during World War II and the shooting location for many films and TV shows. Further down along Hawaii's southern coast, stop at the Spouting Horn natural blowhole to watch ocean waves spray high into the air, and see the luxurious resorts that line the golden beaches of Poipu. Take a break from sightseeing with lunch at a local restaurant (at your own expense). Watch the tropical landscape turn into a red clay desert of rocky basalt outcroppings as you drive up to the lip of Waimea Canyon. Stop at several vista points along the way to snap photos, and then soak in the breathtaking scenery at the top of the canyon as you gaze down into the cavernous expanse of layered red lava rock. Wind your way back out of the canyon, and relax on the return drive to the airport. Upon return to Honolulu, dinner will be on your own this evening.


